Getting There

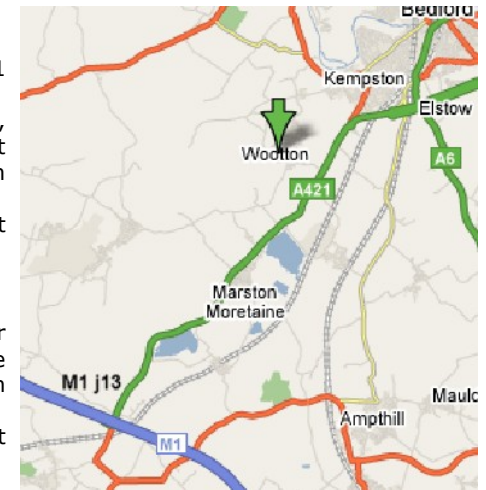
Wootton Village Hall, Church Road Wootton, Bedford, MK43 9EU

1. From North / Bedford area.

From Bedford (and bypass) take A421 heading southwest towards J13 of M1. About $\frac{3}{4}$ mile after the A5134 roundabout, turn right to Wootton where signposted. At the T-junction in the village bear left then immediately right. The village hall is on your right after about 50yds.

2. From M1 – Junction 13

Follow the A421, and about 1½ miles after Marston Moretain turn left for Wootton. At the T-junction in the village bear left then immediately right. The village hall is on your right after about 50yds.
